

UPR of Slovenia. Advance questions submitted by Norway

1. How has Slovenia included representatives of civil society in the reporting process and how do you intend to include these actors in the process of follow up to UPR recommendations.
2. The legislative motion retroactively reinstating permanent resident status to “the erased” was adopted by the government in December 2009. We would like to ask whether there is an outreach campaign planned for those “erased” who currently live abroad, as many of them might not be aware of the existence of the amendment.
3. CEDAW called on Slovenia to strengthen its efforts to increase the number of women participating in political life, in particular at the national level. We would like to ask Slovenia how they plan to enhance awareness-raising on the importance of women’s participation in political life.
4. We would like to ask Slovenia how they plan to address the issue of gender based violence and how they plan to develop a comprehensive strategy or action plan to prevent and eliminate all forms of violence against women and girls.
